All candidates **MUST BRING** along with them a copy of their application form with a color passport size photograph affixed. The application form number will be used for further processing of their applications. **NO SEPARATE ADMIT CARDS ARE BEING ISSUED FOR THE GD/PI. YOUR APPLICATION FORM NUMBER IS YOUR ROLL NO.**

The seat matrix for the admission to MBA program at the DMS is revised subsequent to the introduction of reservations for the EWS category. Please refer to [this link](#) in order to see the revised seat matrix as available on the admission portal on the institute website. In case a candidate desires to change his/her category from OPEN to EWS, he/she can do so by submitting an application in this regard on the day of GD/PI. Those who have already submitted their request online do not require to submit again. Such candidates will have to produce, for verification at the time of GD/PI, relevant documents/certificates issued by the competent authority as per Government of India rules in this regard. **Failure to present such documents/certificates for the verification before GD/PI may result in forfeiture of claim under EWS category.**

Normally the selection process is over by afternoon/evening of the same day. However, due to exceptional circumstances, the process may extend to late evening. In case you are travelling from outstation, please make your travel plans accordingly. DMS will not be liable for any claim in this regard. No TA/DA claims will be entertained for appearing in the GD/PI process.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR MBA ADMISSIONS (AY 2019-20)

- The candidates are required to bring along with them a self-attested **COPY OF VALID PHOTO ID PROOF** issued by any government agency/organization and the original for verification purpose.
- Institute reserves the right to not allow candidates reporting after 30 minutes from the reporting time to appear in the selection process. Make sure you report well in time.
- The candidates are required to present their original documents for verification along with one self-attested copy of all of their original documents prior to GD/PI. **PLEASE BRING ALL YOUR DOCUMENTS IN ORIGINAL FOR VERIFICATION.** The documents required are:
 - All mark-sheets and certificates for academic qualifications claimed
 - Valid Test Score Card for the MBA Admission Test as mentioned in application form
 - Matric certificate will be used for verifying date of birth of the candidates. No other proof is admissible.
 - Reservation category certificates / Declaration in prescribed formats (as provided in the Admission Information Brochure available at http://mnit.ac.in/cms/uploads/2019/01/MBA_Brochure_2019_20.pdf)
 - For candidates appearing in their final examination / awaiting their final result, Certificate from competent authority as prescribed in Annexure 2 / 3.
 - All experience certificates as claimed in the application form.
 - Documents related to any other claim made in application form.
- It is mandatory for candidates whose result is yet to be declared or who are appearing in their final semester/year examination of qualifying degree to submit a certificate, signed by competent authority, from their institute in the prescribed format (Annexure 2/Annexure 3 in Admission information Brochure).
- The caste certificate for OBC candidates should be issued by the competent authority on or **NOT EARLIER THAN APRIL 1, 2019**. In case any candidate is unable to produce a certificate to this effect, he/she will have to submit an undertaking stating that he/she will submit the certificate at the time of registration for the course, if selected.
- This admission to the selection process is provisional subject to the verification of details filled online by the candidates in their application form. In case any discrepancy is observed, the details verified from the original documents will be considered.
- **No TA/DA shall be admissible for candidates coming for test/admission in any case.**
- Normally, the selection process is completed by late afternoon/evening of the same day (May 11, 2019). However, due to unforeseen circumstances, candidates might be asked to stay for one more day after the examination.
- Eligibility of a candidate is provisional as per information provided by the candidate in his/her application form, and is subject to verification of minimum eligibility conditions for admission to the program.
- Provisional eligibility to appear in GD/PI (selection process) is no guarantee for admission to the program.
- The Institute reserves rights to declare any candidate as ineligible at any stage of the selection process if information supplied by the candidate is found to be incorrect and/or minimum eligibility conditions are not met.

How to reach MNIT Jaipur

The Institute is located in Malaviya Nagar on Jawahar Lal Nehru Marg, Jaipur. Jaipur is situated in Northern India at a distance of around 260 km south of Delhi.

BY ROAD:

From National Highway 8: Which connects Jaipur to Delhi, Ajmer, Udaipur, Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Mumbai one can reach to Sindhi Camp Bus stand. From Sindhi camp which is 10 kms away from MNIT campus one can take Bus# 7 and 17. One can also get prepaid taxis for MNIT campus

From National Highway 11: Which connects Agra-Jaipur-Bikaner one can reach to Sindhi Camp Bus stand. From Sindhi camp which is 10 kms away from MNIT campus one can take Bus# 7 and 17. One can also get prepaid taxis for MNIT campus

From National Highway 12: Which connects Jabalpur-Bhopal-Khilchipur-Aklara-Jhalawar-Kota-Bundi-Devli-Tonk-Jaipur. One can reach to Sindhi Camp Bus stand. From Sindhi camp which is 10 kms away from MNIT campus one can take Bus# 7 and 17. Prepaid taxis are also available from bus stand to MNIT campus.

BY TRAIN:

Indian railways connect Jaipur to almost all major cities of the country. There are three stops close to MNIT: Durgapura, about 3 kms from MNIT, from where one can hire a taxi to reach MNIT, Gandhinagar railway station, 2 km away from MNIT, one can hire a taxi or take Bus# 7 and 17 to reach MNIT. The main Jaipur railway station is about 13 kms from MNIT, one can take a taxi or Bus# 7 to reach MNIT.

BY AIR:

MNIT is roughly five kilometers from Jaipur International Airport, from there one can either hire a taxi to reach MNIT or take Bus# 13 to reach Tonk Phatak and then Bus# 7 or 17 to reach MNIT.
