Jean Tirole

Prof. Jean Tirole has been mesmerising the world with his contributions in game theory, economics, psychology, and industrial organisations among other fields for the past 5 decades. His career in academia has been illustrious. He has been the Honorary Chairman of Toulouse School of Economics, Visiting Professor at MIT, and Former President of the Econometric Society and the European Economic Association are just a few of his attainments.



His major academics, apart from winning the Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Sciences in 2014, include Yrjo Jahnsson Prize of the European Economic Association, Gold Medal of the CNRS in 2007, BBVA Frontiers of Knowledge Award in Economics, Finance and Management .
