### **About Jaipur**

Jaipur is the capital of the state of Rajasthan, India. It was founded in 1727 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, the ruler of Amber, after whom the city was named. It is known as the Pink City. Originally the town was built as per the grid plan interpreted in light of Vedic architecture. Some consider Jaipur as the first planned city in India. Jaipur, enriched in a culture of vibrance, valour, and grandeur, is home to some of the most magnificent pieces of architecture in the country. With architectural marvels like Amber Fort, Nahargarh Fort, Jaigarh Fort, Jal Mahal, Hawa Mahal, City Palace, and Jantar Mantar, along with a vibrant and colorful culture, Jaipur is the most visited on the itinerary of any domestic/international tourist. Recently, the old part of the city (popularly called Pink/Walled City) was named as World Heritage Site by UNESCO. UNESCO, while inscribing it as a World Heritage site, mentioned its heritage value owning to a city of exemplary amalgamation of and inter-change of Hindu, Mughal, and contemporary western ideas that resulted in the form of the city.
