
## **Report on Swachhata Pakhwada**

# 1<sup>st</sup> September- 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022

In accordance with the Swachhata Pakhwada Calendar for the year 2022, disseminated by the Cabinet Secretariat and Ministry of Jal Shakti, Govt. of India, the Malaviya National Institute of Technology (MNIT) Jaipur celebrated with a series of events from September 1st to the 15th. Because the threat of Covid-19 is still present in our daily lives, the Institute has been hosting and participating in a wide range of events and initiatives at the departmental, sectional, and club level to promote and encourage cleanliness and hygiene.



The activities included a whole array of events such as awareness campaigns in and around the institute such as the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Villages undertaken by MNIT, advisories and guidelines by the MNIT Dispensary for the entire MNIT family, Swachhta Pledge taken by the members of faculty and staff, widespread cleanliness campaigns in the campus by the various departments, hostels and the estate section, a large scale plantation drive, which was again distributed around the campus covering locations around the administrative and departmental buildings as well as the residential buildings like hostels, a cleanliness drive and awareness campaigns by the NSS Student &Student Core Team (Cultural), and various other competitions like essay and slogan writing competitions, painting competitions to raise awareness among the MNIT family.

This went on to help the Swachhata Pakhwada to become a successful mass movement along with the participation of students, faculty and staff.

## Advisory released by MNIT Dispensary

The Dispensary staff and doctors released guidelines focussing on personal hygiene & cleanliness along with COVID guidelines and COVID appropriate behaviour.

## Swacchta Pledge

The MNIT family came together and took oaths to keep their surroundings clean and to act responsible towards the environment.

The faculty, staff and the students of the Electrical Department, Civil department, MRC, Library, came together for a cleanliness drive around the departmental buildings followed by a plantation drive.

### Plantation drive by Green Committee

To encourage campus landscaping and boost plant diversity. The green committee began its swachhata pakhwada plantation drive by planting a Kadamba tree near the institute's Central Canteen.

Our MTech Environmental Engineering 1st semester students planted four kadamb trees. They also took responsibility for fostering the plants for the next two years. Near the sports complex, 15 gulmohar and Ashok trees were planted.

#### **Cleanliness drive by NSS/Core Committee**

The Creative arts and Cultural Society (CACS) Core team and National Service Scheme (NSS) together took a big stride towards making this nature waste-free and making our surroundings a better place for all living beings. Around 160 volunteers took part in this campaign and contributed to the event's success through their vision and efforts.

Volunteers were separated into groups and led to various designated sites. Students were given masks and latex hand gloves to protect them from dust and illness, as well as brooms, dustpans, and polybags to collect and dispose of waste. Then, with tremendous zeal, each squad began collecting every available item of trash from the MNIT campus. The volunteers also went to canteens and shops to advise and teach them on waste reduction. After hours of meticulous cleaning, every type of plastic, as well as the masks and gloves, were carefully discarded.

## Slogan Competition by NSS club /Student Core Team

The institute organised a slogan-writing competition for the students as part of the ongoing Swacchta Pakhwara, with the main goal of instilling in the students a sense of responsibility to maintain their surroundings clean and hygienic. The competition's theme was 'Cleanliness' and all participants were given colourful sheets with markers. This was their chance to show off their inventive thoughts and devise a slogan that would instantly kindle a fire in the heads of anybody who heard it. Participants were given plenty of time to develop the phrase and create a poster with it. The contest, which took place at the Vivekananda Lecture Theatre Complex, had about 40 students taking part.

# **Bhurthal Village visit on 7th September 2022**




