1.	Date of 19 th Annual Convocation & Venue	:	11th October 2025 (Saturday) 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. Open Air Theatre, in front of the Institute Dispensary, MNIT Camps (Student must report before 9:00 A.M. in Convocation Pandal for attendance).
2.	Date of issue of students' admit cards & Guest/visitors' Pass & lunch coupon (UG)	:	10 th October 2025 - 09.00 AM to 12.00 Noon [at Diksha Sabhagar (Mini Auditorium), Prabha Bhawan]
3.	Date of issue of students' admit cards & Guest/visitors' Pass & lunch coupon (PG & Ph.D.)	:	10th October 2025 - 09.00 AM to 12.00 Noon [at Malaviya Sabhagar, near ICICI Bank, Prabha Bhawan]
4.	Date & Time of Rehearsal	:	10 th October 2025 (Friday) at 3.00 PM sharp in the Open Air Theatre, in front of the Institute Dispensary, MNIT Campus, Jaipur.

NOTES:

- (i) Notwithstanding the above, for reasons beyond control, if the date of Convocation/rehearsal is changed, the announcement will be made on the MNIT website.
- (ii) Students who have registered on ERP for attending Convocation will be permitted for rehearsal in Convocation Programme. It is compulsory to attend the rehearsal for attending the Convocation programme (in case a student fails to attend the convocation rehearsal on the scheduled date and time, he/she shall not be allowed to attend the final convocation programme).
- (iii) Admission to the Convocation venue shall be allowed only after producing the admit card.
- (iv) The programme for Rehearsal/Convocation will remain unchanged.
- (v) Briefcases/Bags/Edibles and any objectionable materials will not be allowed in the Convocation venue due to security reasons.
- (vi) Children below 18 years will not be permitted in the Convocation venue.
- (vii) All graduating students are hereby informed that the dress code for the Convocation is as follows:

Male: White Kurta with Pajama, Female: Off-white Saari (Angavastra of different colours with Institute logo for undergraduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. students) shall be provided by the Institute. Female degree recipients should bring all other accessories with them.
