- 3. Initiation of the discussion on how to recruit more members of all the three levels viz. UG, PG and Ph.D. by Dr. Rajesh Kumar.
 - 3.1 More attention to be paid towards UG students who are more difficult to convince for IEEE membership.
 - 3.2 UG students aspiring for abroad studies will get benefitted.
 - 3.3 For PG and PhD. Students, cost of two conference is equivalent to cost IEEE membership.
- 4. Shanky Saxena raised the issue of fund raising. Member referrals-earned credits may be used for maintaining the funds. He also raised the issue of group challan payment for IEEE membership as most of the students do not have credit card.
- 5. Dr. Rajesh Kumar highlighted the funding opportunities available from IEEE local section and various awards available.
- 6. Shanky Saxena discussed about clarity on affiliation to Rajasthan subsection.
- 7. Anand Kumar Mishra stated that the member recruit process should be started with the members of the faculty of the institute.
- 8. Shanky Saxena floated the idea of a robotics competition to attract undergraduate students with prize money from IEEE.
- 9. Dr. Rajesh Kumar suggested the chair to submit the new membership application through the Delhi section.
 - 9.1 Counselor also instructed to connect to Delhi section and write to section chair

- 14. The counselor concluded that the members shall plan for December and attract good speakers. He also seconded the idea by the Vice-Chair regarding the possibility of inviting research scholars from outside the branch and the institution to join over Skype for invited talks.
- 15. The counselor suggested the members to invite the new institute director for a talk and request him for funds.
